Learn how to construct a variety of polytunnels, aiming at year-round production, plus ideas on crop selection, planting and harvesting times for food production through winter and spring months.

Composting

Sunday 19th May, Windmill Hill Hall, High St Launceston

Tony Scherer, first person to bring the Luebke system of composting to Australia, will teach you how to produce high quality compost, high in organic matter, humus, beneficial microorganisms and macro- and micro-nutrients.

Both workshops will run from **9am to 1pm**, concluding with lunch.

These workshops are subsidised approx 50% by NRM North. Cost for participants is \$30 each, or \$50 to attend both workshops. Includes lunch.
