

# Sediment Demonstration Grants 2011



Tamar Estuary  
and Esk Rivers

*NRM North through the Tamar Estuary and Esk Rivers (TEER) program is offering grants to landholders, community groups, industry groups and local government to reduce sediment delivery to waterways in the NORTH ESK, SOUTH ESK and MEANDER VALLEY catchment areas.*

## Key Facts

1. Eligible applicants include land managers, community groups, industry groups and local government.
2. Grants offered are from \$1,000 to \$20,000.
3. Works must be located within the; North Esk, South Esk or Meander Valley catchment areas and completed within one year.
4. Projects must aim to reduce sediment input to waterways and demonstrate effective and innovative methods.
5. Example activities may include;
  - Stabilising riverbank erosion;
  - In-stream works to minimise sediment transportation or use of sediment traps;
  - Creation of streamside buffers and revegetation activities;
  - Works to reduce sediment run off from roads and tracks;
  - Excluding stock from waterways and trialling the establishment of new or innovative types of stock crossings.

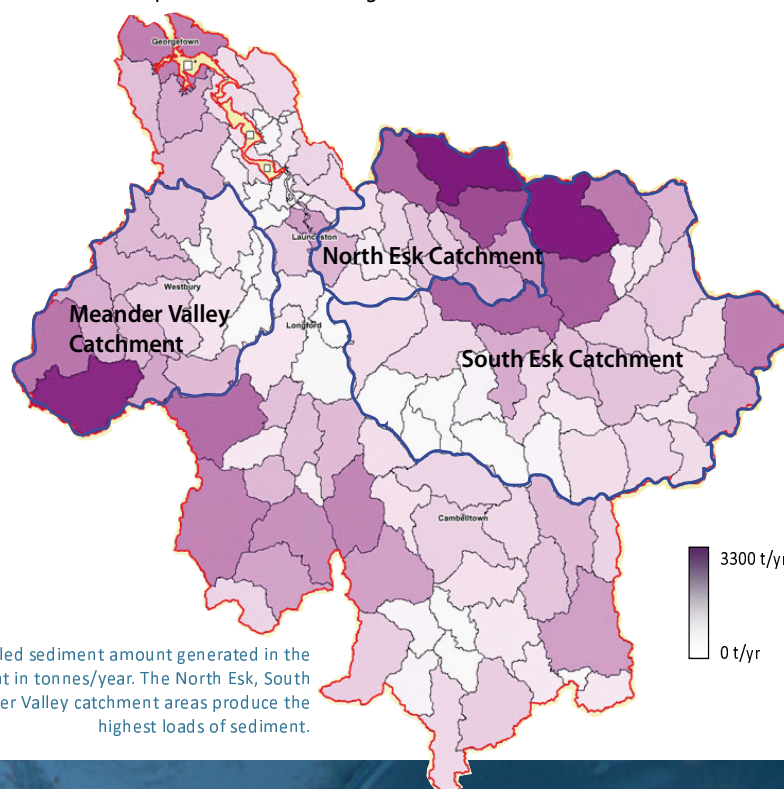

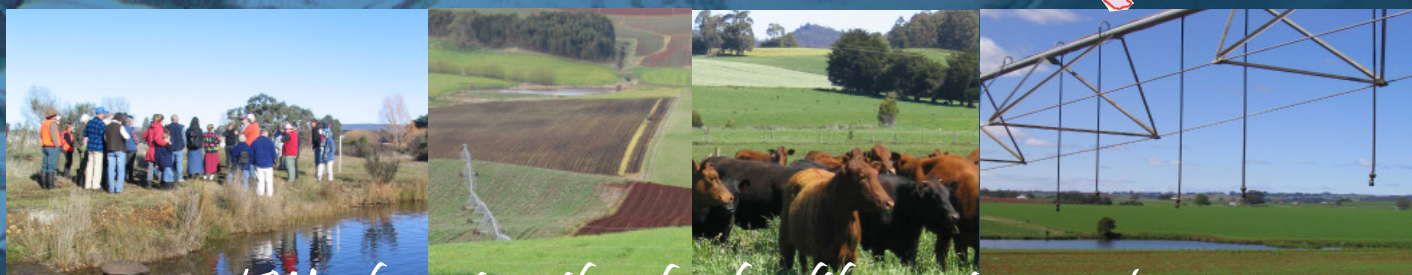
