The Environment, Parks and Heritage Minister, Brian Wightman, will launch a new report card for the health of the river systems in the Tamar catchment **TOMORROW, June 19th**.

The Tamar Catchment 2013 Freshwater Report Card is the first baseline report for the condition of freshwater ecosystems in the Tamar catchment released by NRM North's Tamar Estuary and Esk Rivers (TEER) Program.

It is an historic assessment of the catchment's health, based on data collected by the TEER partners over a ten year period – 2001 to 2011.
